April 28

Isaias 66: 19 INTROIT

MITTAM ex his, qui salvati fuerint, ad gentes in mare, ad insulas longe, ad eos, qui non audierunt de me et non viderunt gloriam meam. Et annuntiabunt gloriam meam gentibus, alleluia, alleluia. *Ps. 96, 1.* Dominus regnavit, exsultet terra: lætentur insulæ multæ. Gloria Patri.

I will send of them, that shall be saved, to the Gentiles into the sea, to the islands afar off, to them that have not heard of Me, and have not seen My glory. FRATRES: Induite vos sicut electi Dei, sancti, et dilecti, viscera misericordiae, benignitatem, humilitatem, modestiam, patientiam: supportantes invicem, et donantes vobismetipsis si quis adversus aliquem habet querelam: sicut et Dominus donavit vobis, ita et vos. Super omnia autem hæc, caritatem habete, quod est vinculum perfectionis: et pax Christi exsultet in cordibus vestris, in qua et vocati estis in uno corpore: et grati estote. GOSPEL

At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow Me. For he that will save his life shall lose it: and he that shall lose his life for My sake shall find it. For what doth it profit a man, if he gain the whole world and suffer the loss of his own soul? Or what exchange shall a man give for his soul? For the Son of man shall come in the glory of His Father with His angels: and then will He render to every man according to his works.

PREFACE OF EASTER

VERE dignum et justum est, æquum et salutäre: Te quidem, Dómine, omni tēpore, sed in hoc potissimum gloriósius prædicare, cum Pascha nostrum immolátus est Christus. Ipse enim verus est Agnus, qui abstulit peccáta mundi. Qui mortem nostram moriēdo destrúxit, et vitam resurgēdo reparávit. Et ideo cum Angelis et Archángelis, cum Thronis et Dominationibus, cumque omni milítia cæléstis exercitus, hymnum glóriæ tuæ cánimus, sine fine dicētes:

It is truly meet and just, right and availing unto salvation that at all times, but more especially at this season, we should extol Thy glory, O Lord, when Christ our Pasch was sacrificed.
