### ST PETER CELESTINE

May 19

*John 21: 15-17* INTROIT

SI DILIGIS Me, Simon Petre, pasce agnos Meos, pasce oves Meas. Alleluia, alleluia. Ps. 29: 2. Exaltabo te, Domine, quoniam suscepisti me, nec delectasti inimicos meos super me. Gloria Patri.

If thou lovest Me, Simon Peter, feed My lambs; feed My sheep. Alleluia, alleluia. Ps. I will extol Thee, O Lord, for Thou hast upheld me: and hast not made my enemies to rejoice over me. Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT

DEUS, qui beatum Petrum Coelestinum ad summi pontificatus apicem sublimasti, quique illum humilitati postponere docuisti: concede propitius; ut ejus exemplo cuncta mundi despiceret, et ad promissa humilibus premia pervenire feliciter mereamur. Per Dominum.

Dearly beloved: The ancients therefore that are among you, I beseech, who am myself also an ancient and a witness of the sufferings of Christ: as also a partaker of that glory which is to be revealed in time to come: Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking care of it not by constraint, but willingly according to God: not for filthy lucre's sake, but voluntarily: neither as lording it over the clergy, but being

GOSPEL

At that time, Jesus came into the quarters of Cæsarea Philippi, and He asked His disciples, saying: Whom do men say that the Son of man is? But they said: Some, John the Baptist, and other some, Elias, and others, Jeremias, or one of the prophets. Jesus saith to them: But whom do you say that I am? Simon Peter answered: Thou art Christ, the Son of the living God. And Jesus answering, said to him: Blessed art thou, Simon Bar-Jona, because flesh and blood hath not revealed it to thee, but My Father Who is in Heaven: and I say to thee, that thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build My Church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it; and to thee I will give the keys of the kingdom of
