Ps. 118: 151, 152 INTROIT

PROPE es tu, Domine, et omnes viæ
tuæ veritas: initio cognovi de testi-
moniis tuis: quia in æternum tu es. *Ps.*
Beati immaculati in via: qui ambulant
in lege Domini. Gloria Patri.

Thou art near, O Lord, and all Thy ways are
truth: I have known from the beginning con-
cerning Thy testimonies, and Thou art for
ever. *Ps.* Blessed are the undefiled in the way:
who walk in the law of the Lord. Glory to
the Father.

COLLECT

EXCITA, quæsumus Domine, poten-
tiam tuam, et veni: ut hi, qui in tua
pietate confidunt, ab omni citius
adversitate liberentur: Qui vivis et
regnas.

Stir up Thy might, we beseech Thee, O
Lord, and come: that they who trust in Thy
loving kindness may be the more speedily
freed from all adversity: Who livest and reig-
nest.

Isaias 11:1-5

HÆC dixit Dominus Deus: Egredie-
tur virga de radice Jesse, et flos de
radice ejus ascendet. Et requiescat
super eum spiritus Domini: spiritus
sapientiæ, et intellectus, spiritus consilii,
et fortitudinis, spiritus scientiæ,
et pietatis, et replebit eum spiritus
timoris Domini. Non secundum visi-
onem oculorum judicabit: neque
secundum auditum aurium arguet:
sed judicabit in justitia pauperes, et
arguet in æquitate pro mansuetis
terræ: et percutiet terram virga oris
sui, et spiritu laborum suorum interficiet
impium. Et erit justitia cinc-
gulum lumborum ejus: et fides cinc-
torium renum ejus.

Thus saith the Lord God: There shall come
forth a rod out of the root of Jesse, and a
flower shall rise up out of his root. And the
spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him: the
spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the
spirit of counsel and of fortitude, the spirit
of knowledge and of godliness, and He shall
be filled with the spirit of the fear of the
Lord. He shall not judge according to the
sight of the eyes, nor reprove according to
the hearing of the ears; but He shall judge
the poor with justice, and shall reprove with
equity for the meek of the earth: and He
shall strike the ruthless with the rod of His
mouth, and with the breath of His lips He
shall slay the wicked. And justice shall be the
girdle of His loins: and faith the girdle of His
reins.

COMMON PREFACE
